Announcing the recipients of the 2024 Wisconsin Titan 100

Marty Brooks has served as president and CEO of the <u>Wisconsin Center District</u> (WCD) since 2018. He is currently overseeing a \$456 million expansion expected to be completed in spring of 2024. As president and CEO of the WCD, Brooks serves as the architect who showcases the <u>Baird Center</u>, <u>UW-Milwaukee Panther Arena</u> and <u>Miller High Life Theatre</u> as three premiere hospitality, entertainment and tourism venues in downtown Milwaukee.

Prior to Milwaukee, Brooks worked in St. Louis where he served as the senior vice president and general manager of America's Center Complex and executive vice president and general manager for the Scottrade Center and Peabody Opera House.

Brooks worked for Madison Square Garden for 22 years and held several positions in that time including senior vice president of programming and production for the MSG Network, president and executive producer of Miss Universe and senior vice president and general manager of Madison Square Garden Connecticut.

Brooks currently serves on the Board of Directors for the <u>Westown Association</u> and <u>VISIT</u> Milwaukee.

"It is an incredible honor to be named a Titan 100 for Wisconsin," said Brooks. "I am humbled to be mentioned in the same breath as this year's incredible list of Titans. These leaders are greatly

contributing to the vibrancy of our community and making an economic impact that creates jobs and sustains families."

Marty Brooks will be honored at the annual Titan 100 awards celebration on January 18th, 2024 at Fiserv Forum, home of the Milwaukee Bucks. This unique cocktail-style awards event will gather 100 Titans of Industry and their guests for an evening unlike anything that exists in the Wisconsin business community.
